News Update- 22.1.22



Dear Parents,

We would like to express our sincere thanks for your continued support and understanding at such a difficult time. We are currently experiencing significant numbers of positive cases in our pupil population, alongside major staffing shortages. We will endeavour to do all we can to ensure provision remains in place for our pupils, attending school. The situation is continually changing, please be assured 'Health and Safety' will take precedence in all decisions going forward, as we continue to liaise with EANI and PHA.

Regular lateral flow tests are recommended for pupils who are deemed to be in close contact. We have positive cases reported in all classes at this time. Please refer to previous correspondence issued from PHA for particular class groups.

Note: PHA - We have been advised that if a child tests negative on day 5 and day 6 of their lateral flow and do not have a raised temperature, they are permitted to return to school. Please note, day 1 occurs from the first day a positive lateral flow test/PCR test has been recorded. Please do seek advice from PHA if you have any confusion regarding when day 1 is for your child(ren).

Pupil Absenteeism:

We will provide some activities of work during <u>isolation</u>. The volume of pupils currently absent from school having tested positive from Covid, are considered to be ill. Please be advised your child is not expected to complete work while absent, due to illness.

Going forward, please be advised in order to support our class teachers, those in isolation can obtain packs which will be available for your child.

It will consist of some activities, as a point of revision for children who <u>are in isolation only.</u> Please access <u>Bug Club</u> for reading materials and <u>Accelerated Reader</u>.

The current situation and increasing pressures on staffing at this time is no longer sustainable.

If classes move into *Remote Learning,* contact will be made daily via Seesaw and pupils will be given, in this instance only a pack to complete, in conjunction with daily contact on Seesaw.

Friends of St. Joseph and St. James's are launching our Smartie Challenge.


